1. Archaeological Museum of Thessaloniki

The permanent displays at the Archaeological Museum of Thessaloniki feature exceptional works of ancient Greek art, ranging from prehistoric times to the end of antiquity.

- Highlights: Exhibits include sculptures, pottery, and mosaics, with important pieces from ancient Thessaloniki.
- Location: Manolis Andronikos Street 6

2. Museum of Byzantine Culture

A museum dedicated to the Byzantine era, featuring artifacts from the Byzantine Empire.

- Highlights: Beautiful icons, paintings, and religious objects that give a close look at Byzantine art and culture.

3. White Tower of Thessaloniki

The White Tower is one of the city's most iconic buildings, symbolizing Thessaloniki's rich history and standing as a landmark of its cultural heritage.

- Highlights: The White Tower now hosts the new permanent exhibition about Thessaloniki, covering its history from its founding in 316/15 B.C. to today. The exhibition offers an overview of the city's history, highlighting its long and continuous historical existence.
- **Location**: White Tower of Thessaloniki, Nea Paralia.

4. <u>Municipal Art Gallery of Thessaloniki</u> (Casa Bianca)

The Municipal Art Gallery of Thessaloniki is dedicated to showcasing modern and contemporary art. It hosts both permanent and temporary exhibitions, focusing on Greek and international artists.

- Highlights: The museum highlights Thessaloniki's rich artistic heritage, including works from prominent Greek artists and contemporary movements.
- Location: Vasilissis Olgas 182 & Themistokli Sofouli (Casa Bianca)

5. Jewish Museum of Thessaloniki

- Highlights: Artifacts and exhibitions about the Jewish experience in the city, especially during World War II.
- Location: Agiou Mina Str. 11
